We invited Andrew Redfern from the Society of Australian Genealogists to be the speaker at our general meeting next **Saturday 11 November.** His talk is about his ancestor, Dr William Redfern. Dr. Redfern began his time in NSW as a convict but became recognised as one of our early doctors within the colony.

Andrew is also passionate about our Colonial history and is an integral part of the 'Ironclad Sisterhood' project from the Society of Australian Genealogists. He has agreed to tell us about this burgeoning project which encompasses the first 30 years of colonial history. If you have a female convict who arrived in NSW, you will be interested in this day. You will also hear about our female convict project, Rowdy Voices & Quiet Whispers that is nearing completion.




